## CONCEPT

In this scale, one foot represents one nautical mile. This makes it possible to fight a game with the same ground scale and model scale. Alternatively, large actions may be refought using a ground scale of 1/12000<sup>th</sup> or even 1/24000<sup>th</sup> without impairing the visual aspect of the game. At 1/24000<sup>th</sup>, maximum effective gun range at Jutland (-18,000 yards) is represented by 27".

Major warships are supplied with a separate sculpted base; destroyers and smaller vessels are cast on the base. All bases incorporate a flat tab at the stern on which you can write code/identification numbers, etc. The tabs can be removed if not required.

### THE GERMAN Z-PLAN NAVY

The Z-plan was designed to challenge the Royal Navy and would have been completed around 1948. There were to be two powerful commerce-raiding battle groups, one in the North and one in the South Atlantic. Each was to be based around 3 x H-class battleships and an aircraft carrier. Escorts for each battle group included 3 x M-class light cruisers and 5 x Sp Scout cruisers, the latter resembling very large destroyers. There were also to be conventional sized destroyers. All escort ships had unusually large range to allow for extended operations away from a friendly port. The 12 P-class Panzerschiffe (and their replacements, the OPQ-class battlecruisers) were to operate independently against commerce, in the manner of Graf Spee. The older ships, such as Bismarck, Scharnhorsts, Hipper & K-class cruisers were to be employed in home waters.
